

## **S-378, Aerial Supervision (Applies to 2009 Version)**

The following error was found in the S-378 course:

Per the Interagency Aerial Supervision Guide, Chapter 7, Page 79; Missions in the same airspace require 500 foot minimum vertical separation. Thus, the answer key on the final exam should be as below for question 14 with answer C as the correct answer, not choice A.

14. What is the minimum vertical separation for aircraft over an incident?

- a. 1500 feet
- b. 1000 feet
- c. 500 feet**
- d. 150 feet
